

**Legacy High School Girls Soccer Booster Minutes**  
**February 8, 2016**

Zanthia Price called the meeting to order. Meeting held at Legacy High School. **Secretary's Minutes:** Minutes from previous meeting available to review. Kevin Hagen made motion to approve minutes from January 12, 2016; Laurie Baumgartner seconded. Motion approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Tanya Guthmiller presented Treasurer's Report. She reports she transferred \$1500 to school account to pay for sideline jackets, etc. School account has \$1,939.58. Dakota Community account has \$10,313.52. Discussion that taxes still need to be filed for last year.

**Old Business:**

**Parent Meeting:** Will be held in Marketplace or the gym on Sunday, March 6, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. Will need helpers to collect money, forms, etc. Sandra Domagala and Kevin Hagen will work on putting packets together - forms, raffle tickets, etc. Coach Tom is estimating 55-60 girls will be going out for soccer with plan to make 65 packets. Coach Tom will get the school forms to Sandra. Tom reported the gym and the field are both reserved for try-outs in case of inclement weather. Tom will be getting the try-out schedule out also. Plan is for Varsity and Varsity Reserve to practice at Legacy and the two JV 2 teams will be practicing at Cottonwood. All the coaches will be at the March 6 meeting with open gym to follow.

**Apparel:** Scarves were discussed. The deadline was missed for free shipping so we will have to pay \$26.79 for shipping. Plan is to order 50 scarves; generic Legacy versus Legacy Soccer. The cost is \$10.95 per scarf with plan to sell for \$15. DeAnn Hiltz made motion to approve up to \$600 for purchase of scarves; Dan Domagala seconded. Motion approved.

**Raffle:** Permit has been turned into the Police Department; raffle proof completed. United Printing will print 800 tickets for \$168.85. Drawings will be April 11-May 27, 2016. Blitz Day will be Saturday, April 2, 2016 and will coincide with practice.

**HUDL:** Coach Tom reported Legacy Girls Soccer will be able to use HUDL without cost this year. Tom also reported needing to find someone to video games, etc. Tom described HUDL to the group.

**501 3c:** Patty Schock presented info on Parentbooster.org. Discussion that taxes still need to be filed from last year. Zanthia asked Tanya to check with accountant in regards to filing taxes and setting up 501 3c account.

**Concessions:** John Baumgartner reported that Bismarck Public Schools will be running the outdoor concessions. John requested a parent of a younger soccer player step into concession role so he is able to train and they are able to attend Concession Board meetings.

**National Guard Night:** May 5, 2016 versus Mandan. Community Service/donated items will go to Tracy's Sanctuary. DeAnn reported she would check with baseball to see if they are interested in doing this community service activity also.

**Game Programs and Banner/Poster:** Zanthia reported United Printing will print 125 game programs similar to last years for \$79.48. Discussion in regards to banner being horizontal or retractable. Decision to go with horizontal banner to tie on fence. Zanthia will obtain price for this.

**Ball Kids:** Kevin Hagen will work on this but needs contact name for Simle. Discussion also to try and get names from feeder elementary schools also.

**Away Game Snacks:** Tabled for now.

**Freshman Team Rep:** Still in need of freshman rep.

**Year End Banquet:** DeAnn reported she reserved Marketplace for May 31, 2016.

**Soccer Camp:** Coach Tom reported soccer camp will be held June 20-22, 2016. Bismarck Public Schools is charging a \$1.00 surcharge per athlete (new to camps). Camp will be held at Rita Murphy Elementary.
